Minutes of last meeting. Matters arising: James has been in touch with "Take a fence" at Delabole, regarding the fence behind the 15th green. He felt their quote was on the high side. There are a few signs that are ready for the course. They just need brackets which may be sourced locally.

The bridge crossing the burn in front of the 16th tee requires work to prevent further erosion under the supports. This is something of an urgent requirement otherwise the bridge may collapse!

There was a short discussion regarding machinery purchase. In particular, a replacement rough mower. In the opinion of the members present it was felt the more expensive, top of the range option was the one to go for as it ticked more boxes and would be the better value in the long term. This purchase should proceed at the earliest opportunity.
